

# Navarro Small Animal Clinic - Boarding Release

For your pet's protection, Navarro Small Animal Clinic requires the following vaccines for any pet boarding at our clinic:

DOGS: Rabies, DHPP+/-Lepto (distemper/parvo), Bordetella (kennel cough)

CATS: Rabies, FVRCP (feline upper respiratory)

All pets MUST be up to date on all required vaccinations at time of admittance. If Navarro Small Animal Clinic has not done the vaccinations, you are required to provide documentation of current vaccinations. If no proof is provided, Navarro Small Animal Clinic will vaccinate at owner's expense.

For the security of your pet and Navarro Small Animal Clinic's staff, pet's are only admitted and released during regular clinic hours. Monday-Friday 8am-5:30pm & Saturday 9am-12pm (subject to change for occasional closed days)

All pets must be free of any fleas and/or ticks. At time of drop off, if any external parasites are found on your pet, they will be treated at the owner's expense.

Our in house diets are Hill's Science Diet Canine Sensitive Stomach & Skin and Hill's Science Diet Feline Optimal Care. If your pet is on a special diet, it is recommended that it be brought with them.

If your pet is on any medications, please bring with them in their original prescription bottle with clearly labeled instructions.

We provide bedding for your pet, however, if your pet is destructive, bedding will be removed for their safety. Please only bring one toy per pet. We are not liable for the destruction or loss of personal belongings.

Pets are leash walked in an enclosed yard with an 8' fence. If you would you like your pet to be allowed to play in the yard off leash please initial below.

I authorize Navarro Small Animal Clinic to allow my dog off leash in the 8' fenced yard. I understand my pet will not be without employee supervision at all times in the yard but assume any and all risk and responsibility for my pet.

A benefit of boarding your pet at Navarro Small Animal Clinic is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. If your pet becomes ill, we will try to reach you at the emergency numbers listed below. If no one can be reached, please indicate below what action you would like taken. Any medical treatments are an additional cost.

Perform the needed services the veterinarian deems necessary for optimal care for my pet until someone can be reached.

DO NOT administer any medical treatments, including any life-saving measures.
